#### WHEEL backgraound

The WHEEL consortium is composed by the 7 original Libyan partner institutions in UNIGOV-eramus+ project (3 of whom were also involved in FOCUS-erasmus+ project), and an addition of 5 Libyan institutions (2 of them never participated in the program before). The Libyan institutions cover all the geographical diversity of the country.

The spread of Libyan HEIs also includes the main metropolitan areas and involves the biggest universities in the country. WHEEL Libyan HEIs represent around 75% of the total HE student population in Libya (290.000 students approximately from a total of 387.000 students, based on calculations done during the UNIGOV project).

There are at the moment in Libya 19 private and 18 public HEIs. However private universities are quite small and represent only around 5% of the students' population. The WHEEL Consortium represents a good example of the Libyan higher education ecosystem by including 11 public and 1 private HEIs:
